 - Who was impacted, what did you learn, and how will it influence you moving forward?
- 2. Consider who has shown you what hope looks like, and tell us about a time when they impacted you.
 - How have they motivated you to pass that hope onto others?
 - Who inspires you to be a person of hope?
- 3. Why do you want to be a part of the Hope Forward cohort?
 - How will Hope Forward positively impact your life?
 - What are you hoping to learn from being a part of Hope Forward?
 - How do you think being a part of the cohort will impact you and how do you plan to impact the cohort?
