

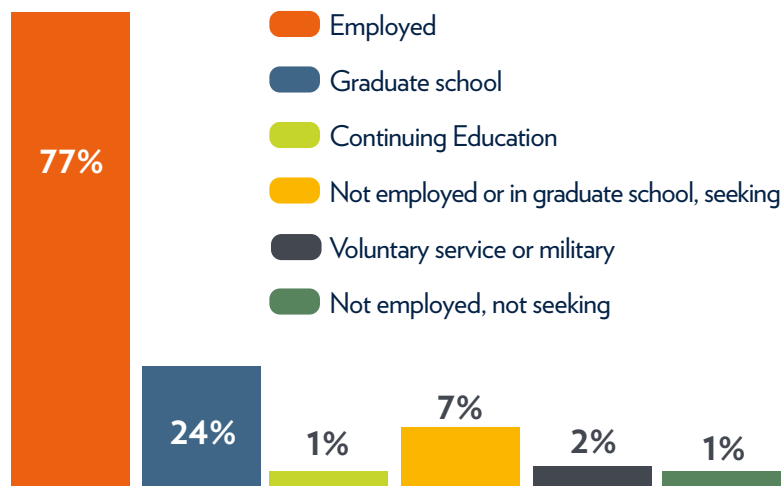

Note: Percentages exceed 100% because survey responders could select multiple responses

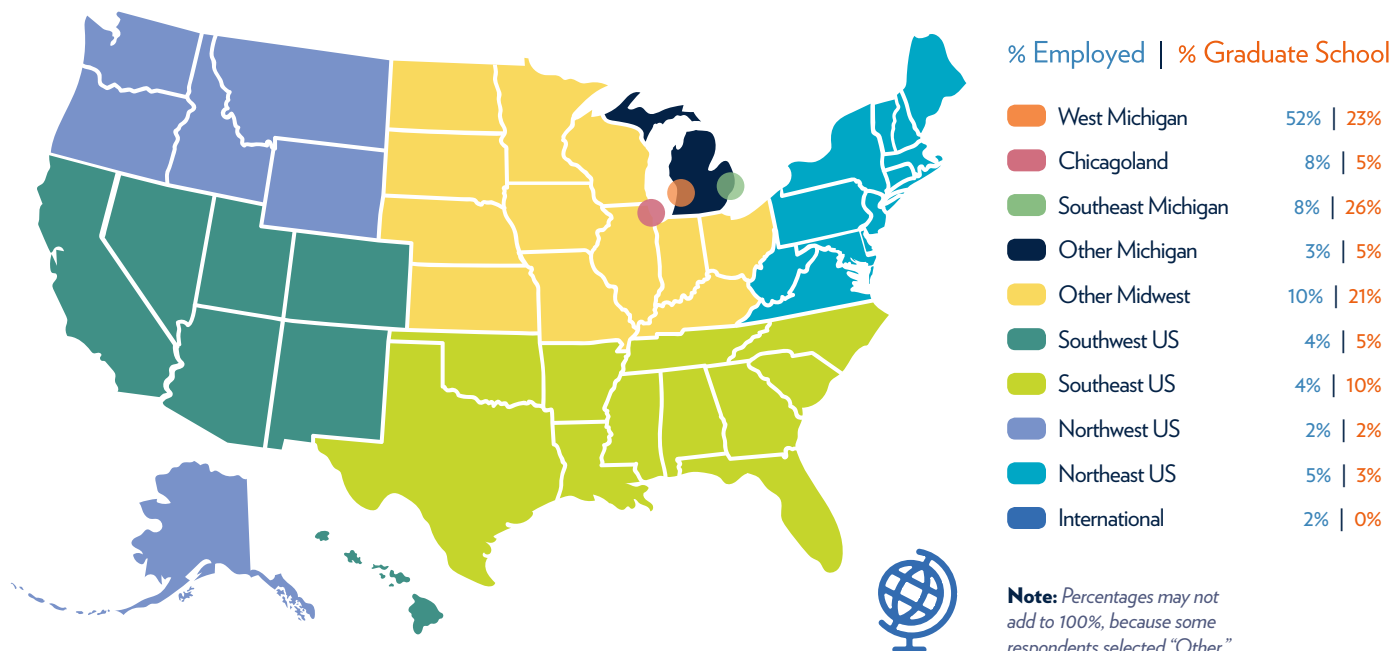

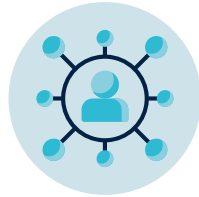
Class of 2023 Employment & Graduate School by Region

About the Graduate Report

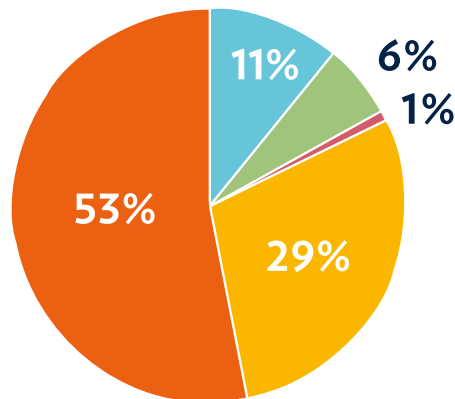
This study is administered annually by the Frost Center for Data and Research, Alumni and Family Engagement, the Boerigter Center for Calling and Career, and Admissions. Alumni are contacted 5-6 months after graduation by email, mail and telephone. This year we had a knowledge rate of 82%, with 292 survey responses; 131 from LinkedIn; and 41 from the National Student Clearing House. 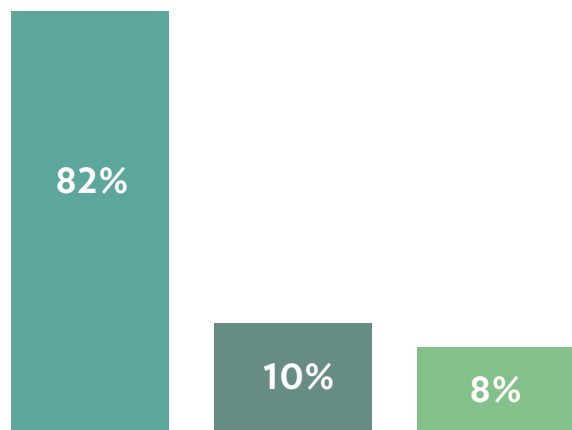
Class of 2023 Employment Satisfaction

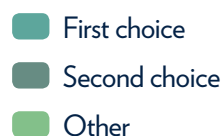


Class of 2023 Graduate Schools

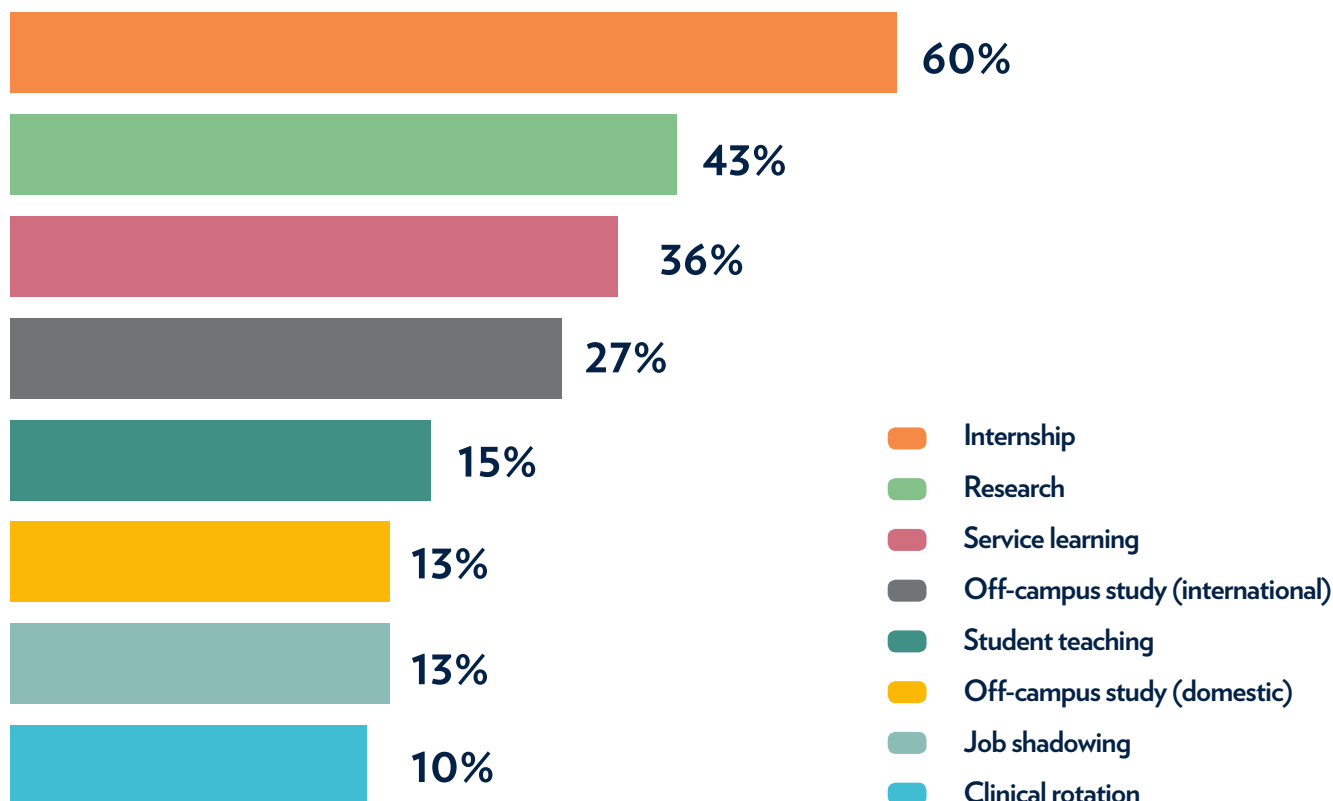
